Due to a high number of customer requests regarding Y2K on all PC 9000 versions and applications, SKANTI A/S hereby has the pleasure of issuing a specified 'PC 9000 Y2K' Statement.

PC9000 switched ON during Year Roll Over:

80486 computers will comply 100%.

80286 and 80386 computers will report the date and time correctly. (Until they are switched OFF and ON again).

PC9000 switched ON for the first time after Year Roll Over:

80486 computers will comply 100%.

80286 and 80386 computers require manual setting of **Date** and **Time** the first time they are switched ON after the year roll over. Hereafter, the PC 9000 will remember the new **Date** and **Time** setting.

Application programs for 80386 computers are from the end of 1997, including the CHKDATE.EXE program developed by EuroCom Industries. This program automatically requests the user to enter **Date** and **Time** if these are invalid.

Computers not having the CHKDATE.EXE program installed require manual entry of **Date** and **Time** at the DOS prompt.

- Exit to DOS ("c:>" or "a:>")
- Press "date mm/dd/yyyy <enter>" for example "date 01/01/2000 <enter>"
- Press "time hh:mm <enter>"

Check the settings by pressing "date <enter>" and "time <enter>".
